

## **Flint Hills restarts Houston propane dehydrogenation plant: sources**

US petrochemical producer Flint Hills Resources is restarting its propane dehydrogenation plant in Houston following a planned seven-day outage, market sources said Monday.

The company said late Friday evening in a message recorded on the community information line it was restarting equipment at the plant.

"Beginning today and for the next several days, we will be starting plant equipment that may require use of our flare system plant," Flint Hills said.

Spot polymer-grade propylene was last assessed Friday at 30-30.5 cents/lb FD USG for June and July deliveries.

Refinery-trade propylene was assessed Friday at 20.75-21.25 cents/lb FD USG.
